Starbuck Thursday Night on the Town is a weekly event held from 4:30-7 p.m. at the historic Starbuck Depot during the summer months. The event has been in existence for over 10 years and was started as a way to give community members affordable weekly meals, as well as help fundraise for various local groups.

Every Thursday, rain or shine, a different local organization or business hosts Thursday Night on the Town. The weekly hosts decide on food and beverages to serve during the event with free-will donations (meals are served while supplies last).
