TOM WOLHOWE

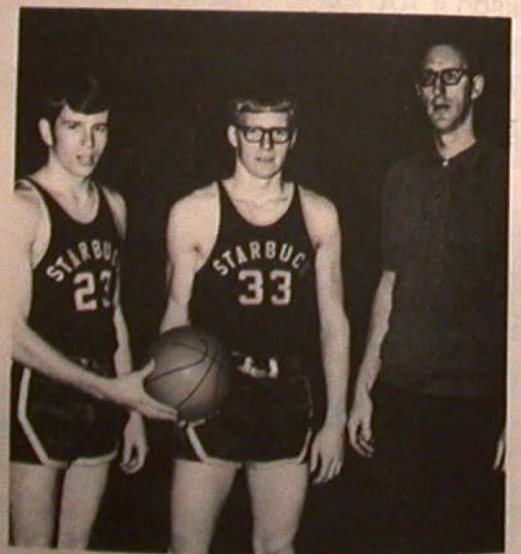
Tom Wolhowe is best known to Starbuck fans as the coach that won three straight District 21 Basketball Titles in 1967, 1968, and 1969. He was in the Starbuck school system for seven years and posted a basketball record of 97-54. His teams were Lake to Prairie Conference Co-champs in 1966 and Tri-champs in 1968. In addition, Wolhowe was successful as Starbuck's Head Baseball Coach.

Wolhowe graduated from Bagley High School. He attended Concordia College where he played basketball and a year of baseball. After graduating in 1960, he accepted a position at Hancock. He coached basketball and baseball for three years. After Starbuck, Wolhowe moved to Staples. His nine years there as Head Basketball Coach brought his career record to 209-192. He also served as a baseball and softball coach.

Wolhowe has enjoyed tremendous success as Staples' Tennis Coach. He has guided 13 teams to the State Tournament and finished as high as second place once and third place on two occasions. Overall, he has a dual meet record of 226-59. He has received Coach of the Year honors several times and has been honored by the Minnesota State Coaches Association for 25 years of service.

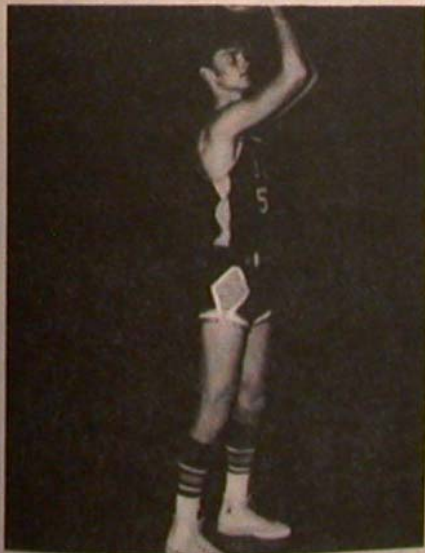
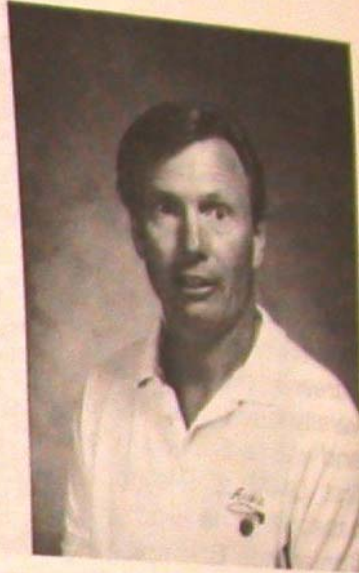
Dave Tank coached boys basketball at Starbuck for two years, compiling a 29-14 record. His 1970-71 team finished at 14-6 and was a Pheasant Conference Co-champion. The 1971-72 squad had a record of 15-8.

Tank graduated from Villard High School in 1963. He held that school's scoring record for many years with over 1,000 career points. While in college at Jamestown, N.D., he earned varsity letters in basketball and baseball.

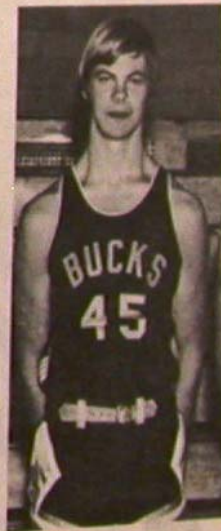
His coaching career began in 1967 in Forbes, N.D. He inherited a program that was winless over their three previous seasons. By the end of Tank's third season, they were a respectable opponent. Following his two year stay at Starbuck, Dave moved to Anoka and was an Assistant Coach of their 1973 State Championship team. He became the Head Basketball Coach in 1978-79. In 1981, the Tornadoes won the State Title. They won it again in 1992. Tank's 1993 team finished as Class AA runner-up. During his 19 years as a Varsity Basketball Coach, his teams have a record of 267-148.

In addition to basketball, Tank has also coached track and soccer. The 1989 girls soccer team was State Champion. Tank has been named Conference and Region Coach of the Year on several occasions. He has a record of 11-1 in four State Tournament appearances and he may be the only coach in Minnesota sports history to have won State Championships in two different team sports. In November of 1993, he was inducted into the Minnesota State High School Coaches Association's 25 Year Club.

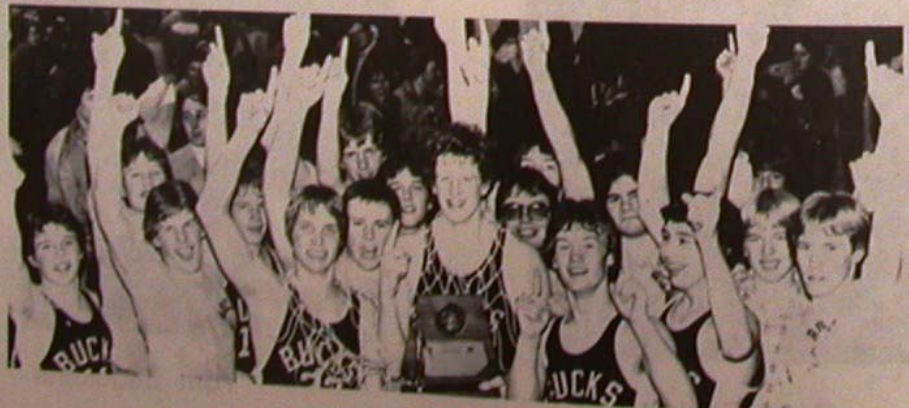

GREG STARNS

If you wanted to assemble a list of the major contributors to Starbuck basketball, the place to start would be with Greg Starns. As a coach, he won the most games (291), coached the most seasons (19), and won the most District Titles (4). His teams won 10 Pheasant Conference Championships. Greg was named Conference or District Coach of the Year on numerous occasions. He also was successful as Starbuck's Head Baseball Coach.

Starns is a graduate of North St. Paul High School and the University of Minnesota, Morris. He had an impressive collegiate career in two sports – basketball and baseball. He earned eight varsity letters, was a multiple All-Conference selection in the NIC, and was a Baseball Co-captain with Don Bright. Greg was the first UMM athlete to be named MVP in both basketball and baseball. He was the top pitcher and hitter on UMM's first Conference Championship team and was honored as a member of the NAIA District 13 Tournament Team.

Starns began his coaching career at Cyrus. The Panthers went 16–5 and won the Little Eight Conference Title. After six straight wins to begin his career, his first game – at the hands of Starbuck. He moved to Starbuck the following year and stayed for the duration of Starbuck High School. District Championships were won in 1978, 1980, 1981 and 1982. The only thing missing from Starns' coaching record was a trip to the State Tournament. That was accomplished in his first year at Minnewaska Area High School as the talents of the Starbuck, Glenwood/Lowry, and Villard teams were combined. The 1992–93 Lakers carried a 25–0 record and the State's #1 seed into the Regional but they were unable to repeat as Champion. In two years at Minnewaska, Starns is 47–8. His 22 year career totals include a record of 354–100, 4 District Titles, a dozen Conference Championships and five Conference Runner-up finishes.



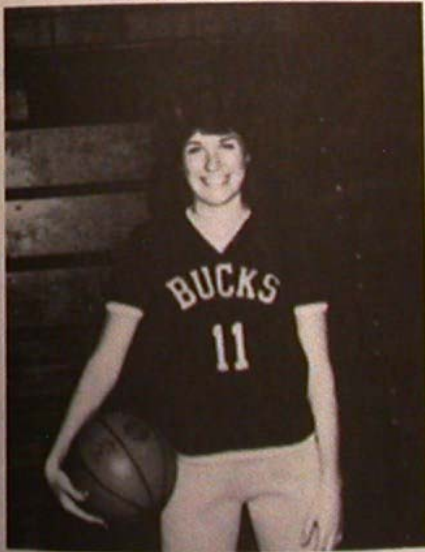

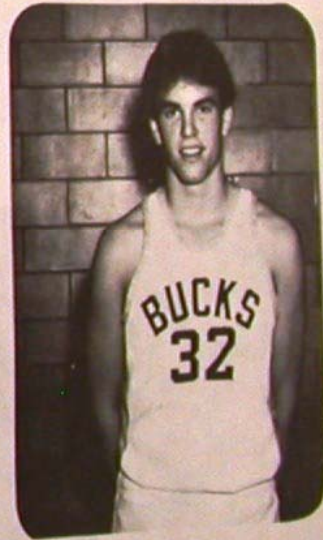
